Eligibility Criteria for Scholarship (Dec. 2021 admissions)

Student can avail one of the A to C categories having highest amount.

Category A: Scholarship for Professionals (having experience in civil industry):

Rs. 20,000/-: for 8 to 12 months Rs. 30,000/-: for 13 to 24 months Rs. 40,000/-: for 25 to 36 months

Rs. 50,000/-: for more than 37 months

Category B: Merit Scholarship:

Rs. 25,000/- for those securing First class with Distinction in Graduation studies having no Backlogs or Year Down.

Category C: Entrance Score Scholarship (Only for 1st Attempt):

Rs. 25,000/-: for scoring 60% to 69.9% in infini Entrance exam Rs. 40,000/-: for scoring more than 70% in infini Entrance exam

Category D: Character Building Scholarship:

Rs. 1,00,000/-: Scholarship for demonstration good attitude and character to be awarded in the names of Mr. Yusuf Nalwala & Late Smt. Sunita Jaikumar Salvi.



General Conditions:

- 1. Candidates shall produce relevant certificates or proof of evidence to be verified by Head Admission.
- 2. For category A, job experience gained after completion of graduation only will be considered & candidate shall submit valid proof of experience letter(s) of the companies & bank statements.
- 3. For category B, transcripts of all semesters (from college / university) shall be submitted.
- 4. For categories A, B, C the scholarship amount will be released after 6 months from the start of course.
- 5. For categories D the scholarship will be declared after 6 months from beginning of course on the basis of good and consistent performance.
- 6. Discount and scholarship amounts include GST component. Scholarship amount will be adjusted against fees / released separately.
- 7. The scholarships are valid for December 2021 PGP batch admission only.
- 8. Decision of the management shall be final and binding.
- 9. Scholarship will be cancelled in case of demonstration of bad attitude by the concerned candidate.
- 10. Documents shall be self-attested and submitted on the day of registration (13Dec. 21) with a handwritten application addressed to the Head Admission.
